- 2011: initial pilot with 4 markets: Atlanta GA, Tampa FL, Dallas TX, and San Diego CA
- 2012: 120 teams over 20 markets around 2000 participants
- 2013: over 740 teams nearly 9000 participants
- 2014: 1,500 teams nearly 15,000 participants
- 2015: 2,500 teams over 25,000 participants
