PGA Junior League Golf is a fun, social, and inclusive opportunity for boys and girls, ages 13 & under, to enjoy the game of golf. Like other recreational youth sports, participants wear numbered jerseys and play on teams with friends. Our Carolinas PGA & LPGA Professionals captain teams in a popular two-person scramble format which reinforces the team concept and creates a nurturing environment for learning the game of golf. More than 2,000 youth across the Carolinas participate in this entry point to the game. In 2016, over 2,000 juniors and more than 140 Captains participated in PGA Junior League Golf throughout the Carolinas. With the continued support of Carolinas PGA Members, 2017 looks to be even stronger as we look to grow this fun, introductory golf program!



Drive, Chip and Putt Championship is a nationwide junior golf development competition aimed at growing the game. This initiative is jointly run by the PGA of America, Masters Tournament, and the USGA and is open to any youth from age 7 to 15 years old. Our Foundation administers twelve local qualifiers, two sub-regional qualifiers, and a regional qualifier held at Pinehurst Resort.
