2020 SUPER SHOW FEATURED SPEAKERS

Rich Lerner - "Lessons from a Lifetime in Golf"

Rich Lerner joined Golf Channel in 1997, and has been a versatile mainstay ever since. He currently serves as a play-by-play host for Golf Channel's PGA Tour tournament coverage, and as a lead host for the network's Live From programming, airing on-site from the game's biggest events.
