Rich Lerner – “Lessons from a Lifetime in Golf”

Rich Lerner joined Golf Channel in 1997, and has been a versatile mainstay ever since. He currently serves as a play-by-play host for Golf Channel's PGA Tour tournament coverage, and as a lead host for the network's Live From programming, airing on-site from the game's biggest events. During Live From, Lerner writes and narrates essays that add perspective to critical moments in the sport, and the players who make them happen. He also reports on compelling long-form stories on In Play with Jimmy Roberts, anchors the network's coverage of the Drive, Chip and Putt Championship National Finals from Augusta National Golf Club, and hosts *Legendary Conversation*, recalling the memorable moments with the game's most historic figures.



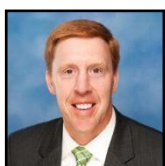
Dr. Bob Rotella – “Golfing with Your Mind”

Dr. Bob Rotella known internationally for his work in applied sports psychology and consistently recognized as the world's premier sports psychologist. His book *Golf is Not a Game of Perfect* is the best-selling sport psychology book of all time. In the world of golf, *Links Magazine* recognizes Rotella as one of the “Top 25 Instructors of All Time,” *Golf World* magazine honored him as one of the “Top 10 Golf Teachers of the 20th Century” and named him “Godfather of Sports Psychology for Golf,” *Golf Magazine* included him as one of the “Top 10 Teachers of the Decade.” It is well known that he works with players from the PGA, CHAMPIONS and LPGA TOURS. Since 1984 golfers coached by Rotella have won more than 300 Tournaments and 74 Majors!

CPGA WINTER TEACHING SUMMIT

Brian Manzella, PGA – “Better Faster: Helping Your Students by Separating Fact from Fiction”

Brian will share how utilizing real world solutions developed over 36 years on the lesson tee, along with the practical use of science and technology, will upgrade your teaching toolbox. Brian is the 28th ranked teacher in America on *Golf Digest's* 50 Best Teachers in America List, his fourth consecutive time in the Top 50. He is a 5-time and current *Golf Magazine* Top 100 Teacher in America. A 30-year member of the PGA of America, Brian was the 2013 PGA Gulf States Section Teacher of the Year and the PGA Kentucky Section Teacher of the Year in 2003.



Robbie Fritz, PGA – 2019 Palmer Maples CPGA Teacher of the Year – “Lessons Learned on the Tee”

Robbie Fritz, PGA is the Director of Instruction at Greensboro CC and will share the top four things he has learned from observing and learning from over 90 different golf professionals on the lesson tee. Fritz is a PGA Certified Professional in Instruction, who earned his undergraduate and MBA from Methodist University. Certifications include: U.S. Kids Golf, TPI, TrackMan, Flatstick, Plane Truth, Stack and Tilt, American Development Model, PGA.Coach, and was a Former Master Instructor at Jim McLean Golf Schools. Fritz was recently honored as a *Golf Digest* Best Young Teachers in America - 2018-2019, *Golf Digest* Best by State List 2019-2020, and as an Operation 36 Top 50 Coach - 2019.
