



## Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout Tournament

The Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout will look a lot like the NCAA March Madness tournament. Based on the initial survey we are envisioning 64 teams competing in a single elimination tournament to see who will be crowned champion! If we go over our estimated 64 team mark, then we will make accommodations for those additional teams. The Carolinas PGA does NOT want to turn away any juniors during these challenging times!

### CRITERIA FOR ENTRY

1. You must be a registered 2020 PGA Jr. League Captain by the deadline to submit a team(s) in the Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout team. *Please note, you must have passed your background screening and your APS training before you can submit your team(s).*
2. You must have a minimum of 10 players on your team (facility) roster. Please note, all players must have signed up through the PGA Jr. League website and received a team kit.
3. Those 10 players must be 13 and under as of July 31, 2020 in order to play in the Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout

Each Carolinas PGA Jr. League Captain is guaranteed one (1) team in the Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout Tournament, but Captains may submit additional teams if they choose. **To qualify you MUST meet the requirements listed above. The deadline to submit your team(s) request is by Tuesday, June 23, 2020 by 5:00pm and your official roster is due by July 13, 2020 by 5:00pm.** *Please note, you can make permanent roster changes, please see the attached "Rule Sheet" in the email to see the official ruling.*

### ROUNDS

**Round 1:** July 26, 2020 to July 28, 2020

**Round 2:** July 30, 2020 to August 4, 2020 \* Round 2 will have extra time due to U.S. Kids Worlds Championship.

**Round 3:** August 6, 2020 to August 8, 2020

**Round 4** August 9, 2020 to August 11, 2020

**Section Championship:** Thursday, August 13, 2020 at Mid Pines Inn & Golf Club

**Additional rounds maybe added if we exceed the anticipated 64 team max. If that is the case, the Carolinas PGA will send updated dates for each round. We do NOT want to turn away any team that wants to compete at a competitive level in the Carolinas PGA Jr. League Summer Shootout.**

\*You must complete each round during the timeframe listed above. The scores need to be submitted by midnight on the final day of each round from the winning team captain. If not, both teams will be disqualified. *Please note, you cannot start rounds earlier than the time specified.*
