Roy Williams - "Life Lessons in Coaching and Leadership"

Naismith Hall of Fame Basketball Coach Roy Williams is one of the all-time greats! With a total of 903 wins, Williams took his teams to nine Final Fours in his careers at Kansas and North Carolina. As a head coach, Williams coached in a total of six NCAA championship games (1991, 2003, 2005, 2009, 2016, and 2017) including both Kansas and North Carolina. Williams won National Championships in 2005, 2009, & 2017. During this Session, Williams will discuss moments that altered his career, the lessons he learned, and how he applied those to become one of the most successful coaches ever.

Jay Karen - "Golf Industry Trends and Projections"

Jay Karen has been the CEO of the National Golf Course Owners Association since 2015, where he leads the golf industry's trade association and initiatives to support the success of the golf course business, the largest segment of an \$85B industry in the United States. Prior to his appointment at NGCOA, Jay was CEO of Select Registry, a portfolio of over 300 premier boutique hotels, inns and B&Bs. For seven years before that, Jay was President and CEO of the trade association representing owners of small, independent lodging businesses. Jay was also with the NGCOA for ten years early in his career, having served the association in several roles. Jay will provide a state of the union address on the golf industry including current trend. He will also walk through a SWOT analysis focusing on opportunities within the industry moving forward.




WINTER TEACHING SUMMIT SPEAKERS

A graduate of the University of Michigan, she played the LPGA Futures Tour before deciding to pursue teaching full-time. Krista spent 10 years teaching in NJ and coached the Princeton Golf Team. She teaches players of all levels from beginner to Tour Players and thrives on helping people reach their full potential in golf. Krista will discuss her passion for the game, mentors, & teaching philosophy.

Sasho grew up in Prince Edward Island where he participated in numerous sports including golf, volleyball, and track & field. He completed a BSc. In Kinesiology at Dalhousie University in 2000. During his time at Dalhousie, Sasho played on the Men's Volleyball team which won four AUS Championships from 1997-2000 and also competed for the track & field team, winning AUS gold medals in high jump, long jump, and triple jump. Sasho then pursued a PhD in Sport Biomechanics at the University of Saskatchewan. During his time in Saskatoon, he was an assistant coach with the women's volleyball team and also finished his CIS eligibility by competing with the men's track & field team in the pentathlon. In 2002, he earned a CIS gold medal while competing with the Huskies. His current research interests lie in the optimization of human movement with a strong emphasis on sport performance. His research and expertise encompass both optimal sport movement patterns as well as the most advantageous training techniques. Sasho will discuss the biomechanics of the golf swing and current methods for increasing swing speed.
