Michael Breed: Life Lessons in Coaching and Leadership
One of the most dynamic, engaging, and entertaining teachers in the game. He is the host of "Course Record with Michael Breed" on CBS leading into PGA Tour Coverage. He is also a regular contributor to CBS Sports HQ. Michael also hosts A New Breed of Golf on Sirius XM PGA Tour Radio weekday mornings from 8-10 AM EST and Best of A New Breed of Golf on weekend mornings from 9-10 EST. Michael has led the way in digital golf instruction, and previously hosted the highest rated golf instruction series for Golf Channel, The Golf Fix. Michael is also a member of the PGA of America and contributes to their digital broadcast of the PGA Championship and Ryder Cup. Michael will share best practices for self-promotion, his teaching philosophy and current trends in golf instruction.


WINTER TEACHING SUMMIT SPEAKERS
