Taylor Zarzour: The Changing Landscape of Professional Golf

Taylor Zarzour currently serves as the Host of the "The Starter with Taylor Zarzour" on Sirius XM Radio and is the radio voice for golf's major championships. He also works as a play-by-play commentator for college football and college baseball for SEC Network's Saturday afternoon college football action. Zarzour moved to North Carolina in 2004 as the Program Director and Morning Host for Triangle Sports Talk 1490/1090 in Raleigh/Durham. He later became the Sports Director for Curtis Media Group in Raleigh, while also hosting his own daily sports talk show. In January 2011, Zarzour moved to Charlotte to join 610 WFNZ, as the host of The Drive each weekday afternoon.

Sean Kennedy, PGA

Kennedy began his golf career in 1993 and has been a PGA Class A golf professional since 1997. A passionate teacher and innovator, he has developed a proprietary skill-based learning process for members of The Cliffs, which has been hailed by Golf Channel's Cameron McCormick as "ahead of the curve." He is certified in FlightScope, The Golfing Machine, and Gray Institute Biomechanics. Kennedy's approach to teaching is science-based in neurology and motor learning. I've spent thousands of hours studying biomechanics, anatomy, kinesiology, physics, kinetics, kinematics and many different swing methods and systems. My toolbox is well-researched and experienced.

Dana Dahlquist

Dana's goal is to help players create swings that are functional and repeatable under pressure, not just swings that look good on camera on the driving range. Originally trained with a background in mechanics (MORAD specifically), Dana's teaching has evolved to understand the forces players must apply to create the matchups needed in their swing. This is fundamental for a player understanding their DNA and producing a dynamically stable, repeatable swing. Dahlquist was worked with Bryson DeChambeau, Viktor Hovland, Beau Hossler and countless other top players.
